

DRYLINING APPRENTICESHIP

The College is now offering the **Interior Systems Installer Apprenticeship**, focusing specifically on the drylining pathway. This is a Level 2 qualification and typically takes 2 years to complete.

We are working in partnership with British Gypsum to deliver the course, which includes the supply of materials, training and keeping apprentices up-to-date with product development.

Apprenticeship training costs:

If you are an apprenticeship levy-payer you could fund this course through your levy payments, and for non-levy payers you will be required to contribute 5% of the course cost. If you are a non-levy payer and have less than 50 employees and take on a 16-18 year old apprentice the course will be free. Regardless of whether you are a levy/non-levy paying company, you can claim a one-off incentive of £1,000 for taking on a 16-18 year old apprentice.
